INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 164-Senators Schuring, Gardner, Stivers, Schuler, Spada, Zurz, Brady.

To amend sections 3313.64 and 3314.03 and to enact sections 3313.718 and 3314.141 of the Revised Code to permit students of school districts, community schools, and chartered nonpublic schools to carry epinephrine medication approved by the students' physicians and parents, and to grant immunity to school districts, community schools, and chartered nonpublic schools and their employees for good faith actions in connection with this permission.

OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS

Senator Coughlin offered the following joint resolution:

S. J. R. No. 6-Senators Coughlin, Hottinger, Mumper, Stivers, Wachtmann.

Proposing to amend Sections 3, 4, 10, and 11 of Article XVIII of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to eliminate the constitutional grant of eminent domain power to municipal corporations and to provide that the power only can be used when authority has been granted by the General Assembly.

The question being, "Shall the joint resolution, **S. J. R. No. 6**, be adopted?"

On the motion of Senator Carey, **S. J. R. No. 6**, was referred to the Committee on Reference.
