**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 192**-Senator Miller.

To enact section 5101.804 of the Revised Code and to amend Section 206.66 of Am. Sub. H.B. 66 of the 126th General Assembly to create the Title IV-A Utility Program under which eligible households receive help with home energy and weatherization costs and to make an appropriation.

**S. B. No. 193**-Senators Armbruster, Cates, Mumper, Spada.

To amend section 123.01, to enact sections 131.50, 1501.50, 1501.51, 1501.52, 1501.53, 1501.54, and 1501.55, and to repeal sections 5119.40, 5120.12, and 5123.23 of the Revised Code to create the Oil, Gas, and Timber Leasing Board and to establish a procedure by which the Board may enter into leases for oil and gas production and timber harvesting on land owned or under the control of a state agency for the purpose of providing funding for capital costs for the agency.
