INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 395-Senators Clancy, Carey, Schuler.

To amend section 3923.05 and to enact section 3923.80 of the Revised Code to prohibit certain insurers from limiting or excluding coverage for injuries occurring as a consequence of an insured's being intoxicated or under the influence of any narcotic.

S. B. No. 396-Senators Stivers, Clancy, Schuler, Goodman, Hagan, Armbruster, Spada, Miller, D., Niehaus, Cates.

To amend sections 3769.03, 3769.08, 3769.083, 3769.085, and 3769.088

and to enact sections 3769.0811, 3769.0812, and 3769.0813 of the Revised Code to authorize wagering at a track on horse races that are telecast via an instant racing system and to levy a tax on amounts wagered in this manner.
