**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 230**-Senators Roberts, Dann, Fedor, Hagan, Miller.

To amend sections 903.02, 903.04, 903.05, and 903.10, to enact sections 149.551, 149.552, 903.021, 903.101, and 903.102, and to repeal section 903.20 of the Revised Code to revise the law governing concentrated animal feeding facilities, to require the placement of the historic village of Longtown on the State Registry of Historic Landmarks, and to prohibit development on land within an historic site that is on the State Registry and that was formed by freedmen or escaped slaves.

**S. B. No. 231**-Senator Schuring.

To generally impose a moratorium for one year on increases in medical malpractice insurance premiums and to declare an emergency.

**S. B. No. 232**-Senators Schuring, Coughlin, Dann, Fingerhut, Fedor, Grendell, Padgett.

To amend sections 101.15, 121.22, and 149.011 of the Revised Code to specifically provide that a public body cannot engage in actions that have the effect of circumventing the requirements of Ohio's open meetings laws, such as conducting prearranged discussions of public business via electronic mail, and that electronic mail created or received by or coming under the jurisdiction of any public office may qualify as a public record.
