INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 245-Senators Cates, Clancy, Grendell, Mumper, Padgett, Schuring, Dann, Fedor, Zurz.

To amend section 2907.09 and to enact section 2907.41 of the Revised Code to generally increase the penalties for public indecency when the victim is a minor and the offender has a previous public indecency conviction, to require that a person charged with a sexually oriented offense or with public indecency who has a previous conviction of a sexually oriented offense or of public indecency was committed with a sexual motivation appear before the court before the court sets bail, and to generally require the court to consider certain factors before setting bail for that person.
