# **INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 488-Representative Yates.

To enact section 4503.762 of the Revised Code to create "In God We Trust" license plates.

H. B. No. 489-Representative Okey.

To enact section 5533.091 of the Revised Code to designate the Lake Milton Bridge, which is located in Mahoning County and is part of Interstate Route 76, as the "Peter J. Delucia Memorial Bridge."

To amend section 5502.03 and to enact section 5502.04 of the Revised Code to create the Infrastructure Protection Center within the Division of Homeland Security of the Department of Public Safety.

H. B. No. 491-Representative Chandler.

To amend sections 3781.10, 3781.104, and 5302.30 of the Revised Code to require fire extinguishers and carbon monoxide detectors in residential buildings and residential units, to direct the Board of Building Standards to adopt rules that establish product and installation standards for fire extinguishers and carbon monoxide detectors, to require transferors of residential real property to disclose whether fire extinguishers and carbon

monoxide detectors are installed in their property, and to prohibit a transferor of residential real property from entering into a transfer agreement unless fire extinguishers and carbon monoxide detectors are installed as the bill requires.

Said bills were considered the first time.
