The House met pursuant to adjournment.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 68-Representative Wolpert.

Cosponsors: Representatives McGregor, J., Dodd, Yuko, Skindell, Latta, Stebelton, Brown, Setzer, Hughes, Seitz, Widener, Chandler, Flowers, Combs.

To enact sections 5533.76 and 5533.77 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of Interstate Route 270 within Franklin County as the "Trooper Wendy G. Everett Memorial Highway" and to designate a portion of United States Route 62 in southwestern Franklin County as the "Patrolman Jerry R. Neff Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 69-Representative Wolpert.

Cosponsors: Representatives McGregor, J., Dodd, Seitz, Combs, Stebelton, Ujvagi, Chandler.

To enact sections 303.024, 307.071, 505.708, 519.023, 713.16, and 713.17 of the Revised Code to permit townships, counties, and combinations of certain political subdivisions to establish transfer of development rights programs.

H. B. No. 70-Representative Bubp.

To amend section 5747.37 of the Revised Code to increase the income tax adoption credit from \$500 per child to \$1,500.

To amend section 959.16 of the Revised Code to apply certain impoundment provisions in the companion animal statutes to the confiscation of dogs under the statute prohibiting dog fighting.

To create the Ohio Broadband and Wireless Telecommunications Task Force.

H. B. No. 73-Representative Adams.

Cosponsors: Representatives McGregor, J., Combs, Evans, Seitz, Stewart, J., Huffman, Schindel, Brown, Yuko, Wagoner, Setzer, Chandler, Raussen, Hagan, J.

To amend sections 4729.01, 4729.17, and 4729.41 of the Revised Code to modify the authority of pharmacists to administer immunizations and to make changes in certain voting procedures of the State Board of Pharmacy.

H. B. No. 74-Representative Schlichter.

Cosponsors: Representatives McGregor, J., Bacon, Wagoner, Setzer, Fende, Dodd, Combs, Adams, Collier.

To amend sections 2907.08 and 2950.07 of the Revised Code to make spying upon a minor in a state of nudity for the purpose of sexual gratification or arousal a felony of the third degree under all circumstances.

H. B. No. 75-Representative Hagan, R.

Cosponsors: Representatives Miller, Williams, S., Koziura, Foley, Skindell, Carano.

To enact sections 5101.91, 5101.911, 5101.912, 5101.913, 5101.914, and 5101.915 of the Revised Code to require certain employers in this state who do not provide a specified amount of health care coverage to their employees to make contributions to a fund to be used to supplement this state's share of Medicaid costs.

H. B. No. 76-Representative Hagan, R.

To enact section 4905.88 of the Revised Code to establish an annual renewable energy requirement for electric utilities and electric services companies that provide retail electric generation service in Ohio and to authorize the Public Utilities Commission to establish a system of renewable energy credits.

H. B. No. 77-Representative Hagan, R.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brady, Koziura, Skindell, Yates, Yuko, Foley.

To amend section 3704.05 and to enact sections 3704.30 to 3704.36 of the Revised Code to require electric generating facilities to comply with certain requirements regarding mercury emissions.

H. B. No. 78-Representative Blessing.

To amend section 101.35 of the Revised Code to make the officers of a legislative committee limited, ex officio members of the Joint Committee on Agency Rule when a rule coming within the subject matter jurisdiction of the legislative committee is under consideration.

H. B. No. 79-Representative Batchelder.

Cosponsors: Representatives McGregor, J., Fessler, Latta, Stebelton, Webster, Uecker.

To amend sections 4121.12, 4121.121, 4121.126, 4123.44, and 4123.441, to amend, for the purpose of adopting a new section number as indicated in parentheses, section 4123.443 (4123.445), to enact new sections 4123.443 and 4123.444 and section 4123.442, and to repeal sections 109.579, 4123.444, and 4123.445 of the Revised Code to specify the classes of investments in which the Administrator of Workers' Compensation may invest the funds specified in the Workers' Compensation Law and to prohibit the Administrator from contracting with outside investment managers for the investment of those funds.

H. B. No. 80-Representatives Healy, Peterson.

To amend section 1327.99 and to enact sections 319.56 and 1327.70 of the Revised Code to require the Department of Agriculture to establish a motor fuel quality testing program under which county auditors may conduct such testing.
