### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

To enact sections 3755.01, 3755.02, 3755.03, 3755.04, 3755.05, 3755.06, 3755.07, and 3755.08 of the Revised Code to prohibit the sale of unsafe children's products and to require commercial dealers and retailers to take specific actions in respect to unsafe children's products they have sold or are selling.
