H. B. No. 283-Representative Webster.

To amend sections 3715.521, 3715.55, and 3715.63 and to enact sections 3715.88, 3715.89, 3715.90, 3715.91, and 3715.92 of the Revised Code to permit pharmacy schools to accept for instructional purposes donations of certain dangerous drugs, including expired drugs.

Said bill was considered the first time.
