INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 284-Representative Brinkman.

Cosponsor: Representative Adams.

To amend sections 124.85, 149.43, 2151.421, 2305.11, 2307.52, 2307.53, 2317.56, 2505.02, 2901.01, 2903.09, 2919.12, 2919.123, 2919.13, 2919.14, 2919.24, 2950.03, 3701.341, 4112.01, 4731.22, 4731.91, and 5101.55 and to repeal sections 2151.85, 2505.073, 2919.121, 2919.122, 2919.151, 2919.16, 2919.17, and 2919.18 of the Revised Code to prohibit abortions in this state, to increase the penalties for the offenses of unlawful abortion, unlawful distribution of an abortion-inducing drug, and abortion trafficking, and to make conforming changes in related provisions.

H. B. No. 285-Representative McGregor, R.

To enact section 119.14 of the Revised Code to waive fines or penalties for paperwork violations that are first-time offenses committed by small businesses.

Said bills were considered the first time.

To amend sections 2151.152, 2151.23, 2151.39, 3313.64, 5103.031, 5103.032, 5103.035, 5103.0312, 5103.0313, 5103.16, 5103.391, 5126.04, 5153.122, and 5153.123 and to enact sections 5103.23, 5103.231, 5103.232, 5103.233, 5103.234, 5103.235, 5103.236, and 5103.237 of the Revised Code

relative to training for foster caregivers, department of job and family services authority to begin the child placement level of care pilot program and petition Congress for expanded usage of Title IV-E funding, the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children, and the coordination of the provision of services for foster children with mental retardation or developmental disabilities , was taken up for consideration the third time.

The question being, "Shall the bill pass?"

Representative Stebelton moved that **Sub. H. B. No. 214** - Representatives Wagner and Combs, et al., be informally passed and that it be taken up for consideration: Tuesday, September 11, 2007.
