INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 604-Representative DeGeeter.

Cosponsors: Representatives McGregor, J., Lundy, Slesnick, Evans, Dodd, Yuko, Harwood.

To amend section 721.15 of the Revised Code to reduce, from fifteen to ten, the minimum number of days for bidding when a nonchartered municipal corporation sells personal property by Internet auction.

Said bill was considered the first time.

MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

Representative McGregor, R. moved that the following concurrent resolution be read by title only and brought up for immediate adoption:

H. C. R. No. 48-Speaker Husted.

To delegate to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives authority to designate groups of members to prepare arguments for and against amendments to the Ohio Constitution proposed by the General Assembly.
