INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 605-Representative Patton.

To amend section 1349.99 and to enact section 1349.38 of the Revised Code to prohibit campus credit card marketing activities on the grounds of state institutions of higher education.

H. B. No. 606-Representative Peterson.

To amend sections 349.01, 349.03, 349.04, 349.05, and 349.06, to enact new section 349.16 and section 349.17, and to repeal section 349.16 of the Revised Code to modify the governance and authority of new community authorities.

Said bills were considered the first time.
