INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 294-Representative Celeste.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hagan, R., Letson, Peterson, Foley, Heard, Yuko, Lundy, Strahorn, Okey, Williams, S., Stebelton, Hughes, Brown, Ujvagi, Luckie, Skindell, Harwood.

To amend section 1739.05 and to enact sections 1751.68, 3923.340, and 3923.80 of the Revised Code to prohibit health insurers from excluding coverage for posttraumatic stress disorder.

H. B. No. 295-Representative Wagoner.

Cosponsors: Representatives Ujvagi, Szollosi, Peterson, Latta, Stebelton, Brown, Uecker.

To amend sections 133.20 and 307.041 of the Revised Code to require that the amount spent by counties on energy conservation measures be unlikely to exceed the amount saved in energy and operating costs over the average system life of the measures, and to require that financed measures be paid for within their average system life.

Said bills were considered the first time.
