The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 296-Representative Hughes.

Cosponsors: Representatives McGregor, J., Webster.

To amend sections 2929.14, 2929.19, and 2953.08 and to enact section 2941.1421 of the Revised Code to establish a presumption that a court should impose on a repeat offender the longest prison term authorized for an offense and to specify longer prison terms that a court may impose on felony offenders with two or more previous felony violations.

Said bill was considered the first time.

The following joint resolution was introduced:

H. J. R. No. 2-Representatives Book, Driehaus.

Proposing to amend Section 8 of Article II of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to specify that no General Assembly session may be held after the date of the general election in an even-numbered year, except a special session, and to specify that special sessions may only be convened on extraordinary occasions.

Said joint resolution was considered the first time.
