INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 301-Representative Chandler.

Cosponsors: Representatives Letson, DeGeeter, Yuko, Fende, Book, Brown, Domenick, Skindell.

To amend sections 5739.02 and 5739.05 of the Revised Code to provide two four-day periods each year during which sales of clothing and footwear are exempt from the sales and use tax.

H. B. No. 302-Representative McGregor, J.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hughes, Evans, Stebelton, Miller.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to create "Ohio Barber" license plates.

Said bills were considered the first time.
