**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 611**-Representative Patton.

To amend sections 109.572, 737.051, and 737.161 of the Revised Code to require a criminal records check of a person before appointment as an auxiliary police officer of a municipal corporation and to establish qualifications for auxiliary police officers of municipal corporations.

**H. B. No. 612**-Representative Fessler.

To create the Local Farming Task Force to develop recommendations of policies and funding that are necessary to encourage local farming in Ohio.

**H. B. No. 613**-Representative McGregor, J.  
Cosponsors: Representatives Huffman, Hughes, Sears, Wagner.

To amend section 742.63 of the Revised Code to provide Ohio Public Safety Officers Death Benefit Fund coverage to investigators and special agents of the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation.

Said bills were considered the first time.
