To amend sections 109.73 and 109.79 and to enact section 109.745 of the Revised Code to require peace officer basic training programs to include training regarding persons with autism or other developmental disabilities.

To enact section 5.2241 of the Revised Code to create "Brothers and Sisters' Day."
