INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 616-Representatives Combs, Mallory.

Cosponsors: Representatives Blessing, Brown, Williams, S., Letson, Yuko.

To amend section 2927.01 of the Revised Code to prohibit engaging in sexual conduct with a human corpse.

H. B. No. 617-Representative Hughes.

Cosponsors: Representatives McGregor, J., Combs.

To enact sections 2907.12 and 2927.15 of the Revised Code to prohibit a person convicted of rape of a child less than thirteen from interacting with a minor without the parent's or guardian's permission and to prohibit a person from collecting any bodily substance of another person without privilege to do so.

H. B. No. 618-Representative Peterson.

To amend section 3323.05 of the Revised Code to specify that the school district of residence bears the burden of persuasion and the burden of production in an administrative hearing regarding the provision of special education and related services to a child with a disability.

Said bills were considered the first time.
