The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 317-Representative Healy.

Cosponsors: Representatives Dyer, Brady, Sayre, Brown, Koziura, Seitz, Fende, Okey.

To amend section 2903.06 of the Revised Code to provide that the penalty enhancement for aggravated vehicular homicide, vehicular homicide, and vehicular manslaughter for driving under a license suspension and the requirement for a mandatory prison term in certain cases of aggravated vehicular homicide and vehicular homicide for driving under suspension also apply to driving under cancellation and driving without a license.

H. B. No. 318-Representative Gibbs.

To amend sections 5541.05, 5571.20, and 5735.27 of the Revised Code to make changes relative to the provisions that govern the placing of county and township roads on nonmaintained status.

H. B. No. 319-Representative Gibbs.

Cosponsors: Representatives DeGeeter, McGregor, J., Batchelder, Seitz.

To amend sections 5727.111, 5727.30, and 5727.38 of the Revised Code to reduce the public utility property tax assessment rate for new pipe-line company property and to exempt the gross receipts of a pipe-line company from the public utility excise tax.

H. B. No. 320-Representative Jones.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brown, Evans, McGregor, J., Schindel, Stebelton, Uecker.

To amend sections 4511.093, 4511.81, and 4513.263 of the Revised Code to require certain children who are between four and eight years of age to be secured in a booster seat and to require children less than age eighteen to be restrained in an occupant restraining device if not otherwise required to be in a child restraint system or booster seat.

H. B. No. 321-Representative Distel.

Cosponsors: Representatives Foley, Domenick, Fende, Evans, Dodd, Seitz, Brady, Setzer, Williams, B., McGregor, J., Gerberry, Book, Yuko, Harwood, Ujvagi, Bolon, Sayre, Stebelton.

To enact section 5533.78 of the Revised Code to designate the bridge that is located on United States route number 20 in the municipal corporation of Conneaut in Ashtabula County and that spans the Conneaut Creek as "The Ohio Veterans Memorial Bridge."

Said bills were considered the first time.
