**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 622**-Representatives Patton, Schindel.

Cosponsor: Representative Nero.

To enact sections 3964.01, 3964.02, 3964.05 to 3964.07, 3964.10 to 3764.12, 3964.15 to 3964.17, 3964.21 to 3964.24, and 5111.0210 of the Revised Code to establish standards for the use of physician designation systems by health care insurers.

**H. B. No. 623**-Representative Fessler.

To enact section 126.50 of the Revised Code to require the Department of Budget and Management to electronically publish information regarding state awards.

**H. B. No. 624**-Representative Dyer.

Cosponsors: Representatives Chandler, Slesnick, Williams, B., Beatty, Lundy, Szollosi.

To enact section 2921.53 of the Revised Code to prohibit the purchase or sale of a peace officer's uniform unless the purchaser shows required identification and authorization.

**H. B. No. 625**-Representative Mallory.

To enact section 5.2241 of the Revised Code to designate the month of September Ohio Preparedness Month.
