INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 646-Representative Collier.

To amend sections 3745.71 and 3745.72 of the Revised Code to extend from January 1, 2009, to January 1, 2014, the time by which environmental audits must be completed in order to be within the scope of certain privileges and immunities that apply to such audits, and to declare an emergency.

H. B. No. 647-Representative Schindel.

To amend sections 319.202, 323.152, 323.153, 323.154, 4503.06, 4503.064, 4503.065, and 4503.066 of the Revised Code to freeze the taxes on primary residences owned and occupied by elderly persons.

Said bills were considered the first time.
