INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 417-Representative Batchelder.

To enact section 5.2238 of the Revised Code to designate February 6 as "Ronald Reagan Day."

H. B. No. 418-Representatives Combs, Williams, B.

Cosponsors: Representatives Evans, Lundy, Setzer, Fende, DeBose, Domenick, Brown, Yuko, Stebelton, Hughes, Harwood, Heard.

To amend sections 959.99, 2152.19, 2903.213, 2903.214, 2919.26, 3113.31, 4732.141, and 4757.33 and to enact section 4731.284 of the Revised Code to revise the penalties and sentencing provisions regarding violations of the cruelty to animals statutes and to include the protection of companion animals in temporary protection orders, domestic violence protection orders, anti-stalking protection orders, and related protection orders, and to amend the version of section 2152.19 of the Revised Code that is scheduled to take effect on January 1, 2008, to continue the provisions of this act on and after that effective date.

H. B. No. 419-Representative Foley.

To enact section 2927.121 of the Revised Code to create the offense of intimidation of a homeless person.

H. B. No. 420-Representative Brinkman.

Cosponsors: Representatives Evans, McGregor, J., Bulp, Raussen, Blessing, Uecker, Batchelder, Adams, Hughes, Collier, Combs, Patton, Yuko, Stebelton, Hite, Gibbs, Stewart, J., Jones, Webster, Bacon, Schindel, Huffman, Daniels, Dolan, Hagan, J., McGregor, R., Wachtmann, Wagner, Skindell, Fessler, Book, Peterson, Stewart, D., Coley, Goodwin.

To enact sections 126.45, 126.46, 126.51, 126.52, 126.53, 126.55, and 126.57 of the Revised Code to promote transparency with respect to state

spending by requiring that certain information on state awards and earmarks, state real property management, state agency management, and state program effectiveness be collected and made available on-line.

Said bills were considered the first time.
