HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS

To amend sections 1337.09, 2109.21, 2111.02, 2111.121, 2307.14, 5305.22, 5711.05, 5711.07, 5907.06, and 5907.09 of the Revised Code to specifically authorize a person to designate a guardian for the person's incompetent adult child and to make corrections regarding incompetent and mentally ill persons, were taken up.

The question being, "Shall the Senate concur in the amendments of the House of Representatives?"

Senator Grendell moved that the House amendments to **Am. Sub. S. B. No. 157**, be informally passed and retain its place on the calendar.

The question being, "Shall the motion be agreed to?"

The motion was agreed to.

INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 280-Senator Roberts.

Cosponsors: Senators Mason, Stivers, Schaffer, Morano, Kearney, Schuler, Padgett, Miller, D.

To enact section 5.2238 of the Revised Code to designate November as "Reflex Sympathetic Dystrophy Awareness Month."

S. B. No. 281-Senator Seitz.

Cosponsors: Senators Cates, Jacobson, Mumper, Niehaus, Schuler, Spada, Wagoner, Bocchieri, Cafaro, Fedor, Kearney, Mason, Miller, D., Morano, Roberts, Sawyer.

To amend section 2329.66 of the Revised Code to increase the exemptions for property that a debtor may hold exempt from execution, garnishment, attachment, or sale for the satisfaction of a judgment or order to reflect the higher exemptions available for such property under the United States Bankruptcy Code and to provide for automatic adjustments to those exemptions based on changes in the Consumer Price Index.

S. B. No. 282-Senator Kearney.

To amend section 123.152 and to enact section 125.083 of the Revised Code to generally require that state agencies set aside a certain amount of purchases for which only EDGE business enterprises may compete.

S. B. No. 283-Senator Roberts.

Cosponsors: Senators Mumper, Kearney, Miller, R., Miller, D.

To amend sections 317.13 and 715.261 and to enact section 319.204 of the Revised Code to authorize municipal corporations to collect their unpaid costs for correcting hazardous conditions or abating nuisances caused by unsafe structures by attaching a lien against the property owner's primary residence, and to require persons with interests in real property to file identifying information with county auditors.
