Proposing to amend Sections 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 15 of Article XI, to amend, for the purpose of adopting new Section numbers as indicated in parentheses, Sections 5 (4), 6 (5), 7 (6), 8 (7), 9 (8), 10 (9), 11 (10), 12 (11), 13 (12), and 15 (13) of Article XI, and to repeal Sections 4 and 14 of Article XI of the Constitution of Ohio to revise the redistricting process for General Assembly and Congressional districts.
