S. B. No. 87-Senator Carey.

To enact section 5502.522 of the Revised Code to create the statewide emergency alert program to aid in the identification and location of missing individuals who have a mental impairment or are sixty-five years of age or older and to establish activation criteria for the implementation of the program.

To enact section 306.55 of the Revised Code to allow a subdivision that is a member of a regional transit authority to withdraw from the authority.

S. B. No. 89-Senator Gardner.

Cosponsors: Senators Buehrer, Coughlin, Mumper.

To amend section 3314.03 and to enact section 3313.621 of the Revised Code to prohibit public schools from opening for instruction prior to Labor Day except in specified circumstances.
