INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 101-Senator Cates.

Cosponsors: Senators Gardner, Mumper, Cafaro, Padgett, Mason.

To amend section 1327.99 and to enact sections 319.56 and 1327.70 of the Revised Code to require the Department of Agriculture to establish a motor fuel quality testing program under which county auditors may conduct such testing.

S. B. No. 102-Senator Schuler.

To amend section 4303.99 and to enact section 4303.208 of the Revised Code to authorize the F-8 liquor permit to be issued annually to certain nonprofit organizations to allow the sale of beer and intoxicating liquor at specific events that occur throughout the year on public space that the organization manages.

S. B. No. 103-Senator Mumper.

Cosponsor: Senator Mason.

To amend section 5303.01 of the Revised Code to require that a person have paid all taxes and special assessments due on property while in their possession in order to use that period of possession to establish title to the property through adverse possession.

S. B. No. 104-Senator Mumper.

To amend section 3901.386 of the Revised Code to require insurers and

other third-party payers to accept and honor assignment-of-benefit agreements entered into between plan beneficiaries and treating health care providers.
