The following bill was introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 117-Senator Jacobson.

Cosponsors: Senators Miller, R., Spada, Buehrer, Mumper, Niehaus, Stivers, Mason.

To amend sections 153.64, 4939.01, 4939.03, 4939.04, 4939.05, 4939.08, and 5739.01, to enact sections 1332.21, 1332.22, 1332.23, 1332.24, 1332.25, 1332.26, 1332.27, 1332.28, 1332.29, 1332.30, 1332.31, 1332.32, 1332.33,

1332.34, and 1332.35, and to repeal sections 505.90, 505.91, and 505.92 of the Revised Code to provide for the issuance of video service authorizations by the Director of Commerce.
