INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 308-Senator Spada.

Cosponsors: Senators Schaffer, Schuring, Fedor, Miller, D.

To enact section 1349.181 of the Revised Code to require certain creditors and utility service providers to recognize the postmark date of a payment as the date received with respect to the applicability of late charges and to prohibit certain late payment penalties.

S. B. No. 309-Senator Seitz.

Cosponsors: Senators Faber, Buehrer.

To enact section 1.472 of the Revised Code to require that statutes enacted that create a private right of action contain express language providing for that right.
