S. B. No. 199-Senator Mason.

To amend sections 5747.08, 5747.98, and 5751.98 and to enact sections 1551.41 to 1551.47, 5747.81, and 5751.54 of the Revised Code to create tax credits for constructing energy efficient and environmentally responsible buildings.

S. B. No. 200-Senator Mason.

Cosponsors: Senators Bocchieri, Fedor, Miller, R.

To amend sections 1551.20, 4933.32, 5709.53, 5739.01, and 5739.02 of the Revised Code to exempt sales of solar and wind energy devices from sales and use taxation.
