INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 203-Senator Grendell.

To amend sections 2305.234, 2925.01, 2925.09, 3715.01, 3715.64, 3719.01, 3719.12, 3719.121, 4303.34, 4729.01, 4729.06, 4729.15, 4729.16, 4729.18, 4729.26, 4729.28, 4729.38, 4729.55, 4729.67, and 4729.99 and to enact sections 4729.271 and 4729.42 to 4729.50 of the Revised Code to require the State Board of Pharmacy to certify and regulate individuals who work as pharmacy technicians.
