INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 207-Senator Miller, R. Cosponsors: Senators Smith, Mason, Roberts.

To amend sections 1315.35, 1315.39, 1315.40, and 1315.41 of the Revised Code to modify the provisions for making a loan under the check cashing loan act.

S. B. No. 208-Senator Grendell. Cosponsor: Senator Schaffer.

To amend sections 2929.14, 2929.19, and 2953.08 and to enact section 2941.1421 of the Revised Code to establish a presumption that a court should impose on a repeat offender the longest prison term authorized for an offense and to specify longer prison terms that a court may impose on felony offenders with two or more previous felony violations.

OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS

Senator Fedor offered the following concurrent resolution:

S. C. R. No. 14-Senator Fedor. Cosponsors: Senators Cafaro, Kearney, Mason, Miller, D., Miller, R., Morano, Roberts, Sawyer, Smith, Wilson.

To urge the Congress of the United States to reauthorize the State Children's Health Insurance Program and the President of the United States to sign the reauthorization into law.

Senator Coughlin offered the following joint resolution:

Proposing to enact Section 19b of Article I of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to provide limits on the power of a public authority to take private property for a public use.

The question being, "Shall the joint resolution, **S. J. R. No. 3**, be adopted?" On the motion of Senator Amstutz, **S. J. R. No. 3**, was referred to the Committee on Reference.
