INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 209-Senator Carey.

Cosponsors: Senators Cates, Kearney, Gardner.

To amend sections 1548.10, 4505.09, 4511.19, and 4519.59 and to enact section 120.08 of the Revised Code to direct that a specified amount of OVI fines be credited to the State Public Defender for indigent criminal defense, to permit clerks of courts who serve as deputy registrars to impose an additional cost for the processing of motor vehicle titles, and to make an appropriation.
