To enact section 5.2241 of the Revised Code to designate March 29 as "Vietnam War Veterans' Day."

**S. B. No. 360**-Senator Cates.

Cosponsors: Senators Spada, Miller, D.

To amend section 3302.03 of the Revised Code to revise the performance ratings for school districts and buildings.

**OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS**

Senator Morano offered the following concurrent resolution:

**S. C. R. No. 29**-Senator Morano.

Cosponsors: Senators Fedor, Mason, Miller, D., Roberts, Kearney.

To memorialize the Congress of the United States to review the allowance of mercury as an ingredient in vaccines and take legislative action to ensure that there is no risk of harm in vaccines.
