The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 213**-Senator Mason.

To enact section 123.012 of the Revised Code to require the Director of Administrative Services to ensure that a certain percentage of state agencies' total electricity purchases are from renewable energy systems.

**S. B. No. 214**-Senator Niehaus.

To amend sections 6111.09 and 6111.10 and to enact section 6111.11 of the Revised Code to prohibit the sale of dishwasher detergent that contains above a specified amount of phosphorus.

**S. B. No. 215**-Senator Stivers.

Cosponsors: Senators Wilson, Kearney, Clancy, Schuler.

To amend section 4503.53 and to enact section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to establish a Global War on Terrorism special license plate available to active duty and honorable discharged persons who served in the United States Armed Forces during the Global War on Terrorism and to establish a Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal special license plate, a Global War on Terrorism Service Medal special license plate, an Afghanistan Campaign Medal special license plate, and an Iraq Campaign Medal special license plate available to any recipient of such medals.
