INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 223-Senator Miller, D.

Cosponsors: Senators Miller, R., Jacobson.

To amend sections 323.152, 323.153, and 323.156 of the Revised Code to require county auditors to make reasonable efforts to identify property owners wrongfully receiving the 2.5% property tax rollback, to limit the monetary charge against violators to five years' worth of reductions plus interest, to require 10% of monetary charge collections to be credited to the rollback enforcement fund, and to provide amnesty for persons who report their illegal receipt of the rollback.

S. B. No. 224-Senator Schaffer.

Cosponsors: Senators Faber, Schuler, Carey, Grendell, Fedor, Kearney, Cafaro, Miller, D.

To enact section 5533.77 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route Number 37 within Fairfield County as the "Chad Edwards Memorial Highway."

S. B. No. 225-Senator Schaffer.

Cosponsors: Senators Faber, Schuler.

To amend sections 125.22, 4703.01 to 4703.15, 4703.151, 4703.16, 4703.18, 4703.181, 4703.19, 4703.331, 4703.37, 4703.50, 4703.51, and 4703.52 of the Revised Code to make changes to the Architects Law.
