INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 245-Senator Schuring.

To amend sections 4762.02 to 4762.06, 4762.08 to 4762.11, 4762.13, 4762.131, 4762.132, 4762.14 to 4762.16, and 4762.18 and to enact section 4762.22 of the Revised Code to modify the laws regarding the practice of acupuncturists.

S. B. No. 246-Senator Sawyer.

Cosponsors: Senators Boccieri, Miller, D., Miller, R., Wilson, Seitz.

To amend sections 124.56, 124.57, and 124.60 of the Revised Code to authorize classified employees to engage in political activities during

nonworking hours, to broaden the prohibition against coercion or harassment of classified employees for political purposes, and to authorize the State Personnel Board of Review and local civil service commissions to remedy such coercion or harassment.

S. B. No. 247-Senator Spada.

Cosponsors: Senators Grendell, Seitz, Padgett, Schuring, Buehrer, Mumper, Cates, Roberts, Cafaro, Kearney, Morano.

To amend sections 926.29, 1733.13, 1733.15, 1733.19, 1733.329, and 1733.34 and to enact sections 1733.241, 1733.242, 1733.243, and 1733.291 of the Revised Code relative to changes in the Credit Union Regulation Law.
