**REPORTS OF STANDING AND SELECT COMMITTEES**

Senator Stivers submitted the following report:

The standing committee on Insurance, Commerce and Labor, to which was referred **S. B. No. 186**-Senator Stivers, et al., having had the same under consideration, reports it back with the following amendments and recommends its passage when so amended.

In line 335, delete " exclude" and insert " deny"

In line 337, after " insured" insert " participating"; delete " that" and insert " , if that coverage exists under the plan for patients who are not participating in a clinical trial."

Delete lines 338 and 339

In line 344, after the period insert " Nothing in this section shall be construed as requiring reimbursement to a provider or facility providing the routine care that does not have a health care contract with the entity issuing the plan of health care coverage, or as prohibiting a plan of health care coverage that does not have a health care contract with the provider or facility providing the routine care from negotiating a single case or other agreement for coverage."

In line 387, delete the comma

In line 388, delete " items, and drugs"; delete " usual and customary standard" and insert " coverage provided in the plan of health coverage or arrangement"

In line 389, delete " of care"

In line 390, delete " a health care provider" and insert " is"

In line 391, delete " provides to" and insert " covered for"

In line 392, after " trial" insert " , and that was not necessitated solely because of the trial"

In line 393, delete " A" and insert " For purposes of this section, a"

In line 400, after " investigational" insert " or experimental"
