To enact sections 3701.63, 3701.64, and 5101.135 of the Revised Code to require the Director of Health to establish the Shaken Baby Syndrome Education Program and to require the Department of Job and Family Services to record in the statewide automated child welfare information system whether a reported case of child abuse involved shaken baby syndrome.

With the following additional amendments, in which the concurrence of the Senate is requested.

Delete lines 34 through 38 and insert:

" (7) "Shaken Baby Syndrome" means signs and symptoms, including, but not limited to, retinal hemorrhages in one or both eyes, subdural hematoma, or brain swelling, resulting from the violent shaking or the shaking and impacting of the head of an infant or small child."
