INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 256-Senator Wilson.

Cosponsors: Senators Cafaro, Goodman, Morano, Kearney, Boccieri.

To amend sections 2903.11 and 2929.14 and to enact section 2941.1421 of the Revised Code to allow a court to impose an additional prison term upon an offender who commits felonious assault against a minor.

S. B. No. 257-Senator Wilson.

Cosponsors: Senators Fedor, Mason, Faber, Seitz.

To enact section 5533.92 of the Revised Code to designate State Route 7 within Mingo Junction as the "Joe Fortunato Highway."

S. B. No. 258-Senator Kearney.

To enact section 125.083 of the Revised Code to generally require that state agencies set aside a certain amount of purchases for which only small business enterprises may compete.
