INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 382-Senator Schaffer.

To enact section 3313.538 of the Revised Code to prohibit disqualification of certain students who live with legal or temporary custodians or with guardians from interscholastic athletics solely because their parents do not reside in the state.

S. B. No. 383-Senator Mumper.

To amend sections 903.01, 903.02, 903.03, 903.04, 903.05, 903.06, 903.07, 903.08, 903.081, 903.082, 903.09, 903.10, 903.15, 903.16, 903.17, and 6111.03 of the Revised Code to revise the Concentrated Animal Feeding Facilities Law.

To amend sections 109.58, 109.60, and 109.61 of the Revised Code to require all law enforcement agencies to take and process the fingerprints of persons arrested for specified offenses and to amend the court's role in ordering fingerprints to be taken from persons who were not fingerprinted when arrested or taken into custody.

To amend sections 959.99, 2152.19, 2903.213, 2903.214, 2919.26, 3113.31, 4732.141, and 4757.33 and to enact section 4731.284 of the Revised Code to revise the penalties and sentencing provisions regarding violations of the cruelty to animals statutes and to include the protection of companion animals in temporary protection orders, domestic violence protection orders, anti-stalking protection orders, and related protection orders.
