INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 449-Representative Ujvagi.

Cosponsor: Representative Yuko.

To amend sections 2108.72 and 2108.73 of the Revised Code to allow a DD Form 93, Record of Emergency Data, to satisfy the written declaration requirements for designating a person authorized to direct disposition of human remains.

H. B. No. 450-Representatives Driehaus, Bolon.

Cosponsors: Representatives Oelslager, Domenick, Yuko, Garland, Gardner, Patten, Chandler, Winburn, Letson.

To amend section 2903.13 of the Revised Code to increase the penalty for assault when the victim is a registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse engaged in the performance of official duties whom the offender knows or has reasonable cause to believe is a registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse.

Said bills were considered the first time.
