INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 463-Representative Moran.

Cosponsors: Representatives Murray, Pillich, Harris, Domenick, Letson, Pryor, Hagan.

To amend sections 4507.03 and 4511.53 of the Revised Code to allow a person who has a valid driver's license to operate an enclosed three-wheel motorcycle equipped with both a steering wheel and an electric motor without being required to have a motorcycle operator's endorsement and to allow operation of an enclosed three-wheel motorcycle without wearing a helmet or safety glasses.

Said bill was considered the first time.
