INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 470-Representative Dyer.

Cosponsors: Representatives Okey, Domenick, Pryor, Hagan.

To enact section 4113.25 of the Revised Code to prohibit employment discrimination against smokers.

H. B. No. 471-Representative Chandler.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hagan, Foley, Stebelton, Letson, Yuko.

To enact sections 303.024, 307.071, 505.708, 519.023, 713.16, and 713.17 of the Revised Code to permit townships, counties, and combinations of townships, counties, and municipal corporations to establish transfer of development rights programs.

H. B. No. 472-Representatives Lundy, Patten.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hite, Murray, Phillips, Belcher, Foley, Harwood, Hagan, Pryor, Bolon, Letson, Heard, Yuko.

To amend section 5739.02 and to enact sections 3346.01 to 3346.07 of the Revised Code to enact the "Textbook Affordability Act" with respect to college textbook sales.

Said bills were considered the first time.
