INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 131-Representatives Wagner, Otterman.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hackett, Murray, Gardner, Grossman, Huffman, Uecker, Stebelton, Brown.

To enact section 5537.051 of the Revised Code to make the Ohio Turnpike Commission responsible for major maintenance and repair and replacement of grade separations at intersections of any turnpike project with county and township roads.

H. B. No. 132-Representative Maag.

Cosponsors: Representatives Uecker, Bubp, McClain, Stebelton, Huffman, Adams, J., Derickson, Grossman.

To enact section 2907.324 of the Revised Code to prohibit a minor, by use of a telecommunications device, from recklessly creating, receiving, exchanging, sending, or possessing a photograph or other material showing a minor in a state of nudity.

H. B. No. 133-Representative Batchelder.

Cosponsor: Representative Hall.

To enact sections 4501.14 and 4503.94 of the Revised Code to create "Teen Driver Education" license plates.

Said bills were considered the first time.
