INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 496-Representative Jordan.

Cosponsors: Representatives Adams, J., Boose, Combs.

To enact sections 131.70 and 131.71 of the Revised Code to assert the state's claim of sovereignty pursuant to the Tenth Amendment to the United States Constitution, to require Ohio residents to remit federal taxes to the Treasurer of State, to require that those taxes be retained by the state for its own use to the extent the General Assembly finds that the federal government penalized the state for failing to comply with a federal mandate determined by the General Assembly to be unconstitutional or to the extent directed by a statewide ballot initiative, and to declare an emergency.

H. B. No. 497-Representatives Boose, Balderson.

Cosponsors: Representatives Burke, Sears, Evans, Wagner, Stebelton, Adams, J., Martin, Mecklenborg, Grossman, Combs, Huffman, Bacon, Derickson, Wachtmann, Gardner, McClain, Jordan, Hottinger.

To amend sections 5112.40, 5112.41, and 5112.46 of the Revised Code to revise the law governing hospital assessments and to provide that the provisions of this act terminate on October 1, 2011, when sections 5112.40, 5112.41, and 5112.46 of the Revised Code are repealed on that date.

Said bills were considered the first time.
