INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 137-Representative Weddington.

Cosponsors: Representatives Williams, B., Luckie, Williams, S., Domenick, Heard.

To amend sections 4301.17, 4303.26, and 4303.292 of the Revised Code to prohibit the Division of Liquor Control from issuing a retail liquor permit or entering into an agency liquor contract if the permit location or liquor agency store is proposed to be located within one thousand feet from a school, church, library, public playground, or township park.

H. B. No. 138-Representative Weddington.

Cosponsors: Representatives Chandler, Boyd, Letson, Skindell.

To amend section 5120.13 of the Revised Code to authorize an inmate of a state correctional facility who has more than \$100 in a personal account to request the investment of the amount over \$100 in any series of United States savings bonds or in certificates of deposit.

H. B. No. 139-Representative Dolan.

Cosponsors: Representatives Uecker, Sears, Zehringer, Combs, Grossman, Hagan, Lehner, Mecklenborg, Yuko, Winburn.

To enact section 3313.538 of the Revised Code to permit certain students to participate in interscholastic athletics.

Said bills were considered the first time.
