INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 499-Representative Yuko.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hagan, Newcomb, Driehaus, Pryor, Pillich, Domenick, Burke, Murray, McGregor, Letson, Oelslager, Gardner, Mallory, Okey, Hottinger, Sears, Harris, Chandler, Foley, Moran, Garland, Dyer, Snitchler, Hackett, Blair, Book, Stautberg, DeGeeter, Koziura, Hite, Stewart, Batchelder.

To amend section 5111.20 of the Revised Code to revise the types of costs included in determining nursing facilities' Medicaid reimbursement rates.

H. B. No. 500-Representative Yuko.

Cosponsors: Representatives Pryor, DeGeeter, Letson, Chandler, Hagan.

To amend sections 3313.60, 3313.6011, 3314.03, and 3326.11 and to enact sections 5.2266, 3301.24, and 3313.6016 of the Revised Code to require public schools to provide concentrated instruction in substance abuse prevention during May, to require the State Board of Education to adopt guidelines for the development of a substance abuse prevention curriculum, and to designate May as "Substance Abuse Awareness and Education Month."

Said bills were considered the first time.
