INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 511-Representatives Bubp, Uecker.

To enact section 3901.87 of the Revised Code to prohibit qualified health plans from providing coverage for certain abortions.

To enact new sections 2151.56, 2151.57, 2151.58, and 2151.59 and to repeal sections 2151.56, 2151.57, 2151.58, 2151.59, 2151.60, and 2151.61 of the Revised Code to ratify, enact into law, and enter into as a party the Interstate Compact for Juveniles; to provide for certain entities and officials and assign certain responsibilities that relate to that Compact; and to repeal the current Interstate Compact on Juveniles.

To amend sections 109.572, 4763.01, 4763.05, 4763.15, and 4763.19 and to enact sections 4768.01 to 4768.14 and 4768.99 of the Revised Code to regulate appraisal management companies.

H. B. No. 516-Representative Pillich.

To amend sections 5751.20 and 5751.21 of the Revised Code to modify the school district reimbursement schedule for the loss of revenue from the tangible personal property tax phase-out.

To enact section 5.074 of the Revised Code to designate the Great Serpent Mound as the official effigy mound of the state.

To enact section 5533.591 of the Revised Code to designate the portion of United States Route 23 within Scioto County only as the "Branch Wesley Rickey Memorial Highway."
