INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 555-Representative Williams, B.

To enact section 5533.373 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of Interstate Route 77 within Summit County the "Gunnery Sergeant Robert L. Gilbert II Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 556-Representative Williams, S.

To enact section 4113.13 of the Revised Code to prohibit employers from including on an employment application any question concerning whether an applicant has pleaded guilty to or been convicted of a felony.
