In line 36, delete " section 1717.05 of the Revised Code" and insert " state law"

In line 43, after "have" insert "exclusive"

In line 45, after " <u>state</u>" insert " <u>, subject only to the authority of the General Assembly</u>"

In line 51, delete " <u>Department of Agriculture</u>" and insert " <u>the state department that regulates agriculture</u>"

In line 53, delete " $\underline{\text{shall}}$ " and insert " $\underline{\text{may}}$ "; delete " $\underline{\text{are}}$ " and insert " $\underline{\text{it}}$ $\underline{\text{deems}}$ "

Delete line 54

In line 55, delete everything before the underlined period and insert " to carry out the purposes of this section, to facilitate the execution of the duties of the Board and the state department that regulates agriculture under this section, and to set the terms of office of the Board members and conditions for the Board members' service on the Board.

- (E) This section shall be liberally construed in favor of its purposes and no other provision of the Constitution shall impair or limit the power granted by this section.
- (F) If any part of this section is held invalid, the remainder of this section shall not be affected by that holding and shall continue in full force and effect"
